

Exam Syllabus Overview

General Intelligence & Reasoning

This section is designed to evaluate the candidate's logical thinking, analytical ability, and observation skills. Questions may be asked from topics like non-verbal reasoning, similarities and differences, analogy, visual memory, spatial understanding, relationship concepts, arithmetic reasoning, figure classification, coding-decoding, number patterns, and series-based problems.

General Knowledge & Current Affairs

This part checks the candidate's awareness of current events and general surroundings. Questions may cover topics related to India and neighboring countries including History, Geography, Sports, Culture, Economy, Indian Constitution, Politics, and Scientific Developments. The level of questions will be based on everyday knowledge expected from an educated person.

Elementary Mathematics

The mathematics section will include basic numerical and calculation-based questions. Important topics may include Number System, Decimals, Fractions, Percentage, Ratio & Proportion, Average, Interest, Profit & Loss, Discount, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Mensuration, and other fundamental arithmetic operations.

English / Hindi Language

This section tests the candidate's basic understanding and comprehension skills in English or Hindi language. Questions will focus on simple language usage, grammar understanding, and reading ability.
